## **2. TICKETS**

Most important thing – DON'T FORGET YOUR TICKETS!

All tickets have a unique anti-fraud feature. Security guards will check every ticket and anyone caught with a fake ticket will be handed over to police. BE WARNED.

If you bought your tickets through MOSHTIX, bring your MOSHTIX card or the credit card that was used to purchase the tickets. This includes the early bird promotion through MYSPACE/MOSHTIX.

## **3. NO PASS OUTS**

There will be NO PASS OUTS for anyone.

Make sure you bring enough cash/warm clothes/cigarettes to last the day. There will be EFTPOS ATMs near the bar, but as these mobile machines have a tendency to be somewhat unreliable, make sure you bring enough cash to get you through the day.

The Merchandise Tent will have EFTPOS facilities, but will not issue cash.

## **4. WHAT TO WEAR**

We play rain, hail or shine, so make sure you dress appropriately – hat, sunscreen, something warm at night, a light raincoat if it looks like rain, etc, etc. You know the drill.

Glamorous gear looks sexy, thongs are awesome, but think carefully if you plan to hit the mosh-pit. Crushed toes and broken heels are no fun when you are walking home!

## **5. CLOAK ROOM**

We have a cloak room this year. Cost is \$3 a bag to store your stuff. Space is limited, so please don't bring half your bedroom with the notion of keeping it in the cloak room. It will be manned by volunteers so be nice to them!

The cloak room will also host Lost Property.

## **6. CASH**

As mentioned earlier, there will be EFTPOS ATMs near the bar, but as these mobile machines have a tendency to be somewhat unreliable, make sure you bring enough cash to get you through the day.

The Merchandise Tent and Bars have EFTPOS facilities but will not issue cash.

## **7. GETTING TO MAITLAND SHOWGROUND**

### **CAR**

The easiest and most comfortable way to get to Maitland is to drive. Make sure you have a designated driver as there will be random breath test units on the roads heading back to Newcastle and up the Valley. A good plan is to get some mates together and car pool, hire a mini-van or book a mini-cab to drop you off and pick you up and the end of the night. There is limited parking in the showground that will cost \$2. The best option to avoid traffic and congestion is to park away from the showground and walk to the venue. There is ample parking around Maitland Park and High Street.

If you can't or don't want to drive, check out the following options:

### **BUS**

Port Stephens Buses will provide a shuttle service that will operate between Newcastle Station and Maitland Showground from 10am to 3pm. There are 20 buses, which is a bus leaving every 5 minutes. Cost is \$5.

People with alcohol or who turn up heavily intoxicated will not be allowed on the bus.

For the return trip to Newcastle, there will be 40 buses ready to shuttle people back to Newcastle. This service will start at 9pm. Cost of the return trip is zero.

### **TRAIN**

Extra trains services have been scheduled to run between Newcastle and Maitland on Saturday morning. Remember to get off at High Street. These services will start at about 9am and go through until the evening. There will be transit police on these services, so make sure you have a ticket and don't bring any alcohol on board. People with alcohol or who turn up heavily intoxicated will not be allowed on the train.

For the return trip there will be 8 extra services from High Street to Newcastle, leaving from about 9.30pm.

**Please be advised that the train service between Newcastle and Maitland is only 2 carriages, so it gets very crowded. If this does not appeal to you, the more comfortable option is the bus.**

## **8. HAVE A GREAT DAY**

We have doubled the area, doubled the number of entry staff, doubled the number of toilets, doubled the number of food stalls and have 2 big bars. But please remember that it will be a big crowd and there will be queues.
